SUBJECT: Official Call of the 2012 Annual General Conference (35<sup>th</sup> of the Enlisted Association of the National Guard of Tennessee (EANGTN), March 1-4, 2012

TO: All Members, Enlisted Association of the National Guard of Tennessee, their Spouse and or Guest

The 35<sup>th</sup> Conference of the Enlisted Association of the National Guard of Tennessee will be held in conjunction with the 83<sup>rd</sup> Annual General Conference of the National Guard Association of Tennessee at Murfreesboro, Tennessee, March 1-4, 2012. All activities of the Conference will be conducted at the Embassy Suites Murfreesboro Hotel and Conference Center, 1200 Conference Center Blvd, Murfreesboro, TN 37129.

Tentatively, our speakers for the Business Session, Saturday Morning, March 3, 2012 are our Commander-In-Chief, Governor Bill Haslam; Chief of National Guard Bureau, General Craig McKinley; and the Adjutant General of Tennessee, MG Terry "Max" Haston.

EANGTN and NGATN members will meet jointly to hear from our guest speakers, but will meet separately to conduct their Association business.

The Conference Registration Form, **enclosure #1** of this announcement, is required for your attendance at the General Conference. Please complete the form and return it to this office, with the appropriate registration fees, no later than Wednesday, February 1, 2012 to take advantage of the reduced pre-registration cost. If you are an EANGTN or NGATN member and desire to register online, go to [www.ngatn.org](http://www.ngatn.org), navigate to the Association tab and click on 2012 Conference. Any registrations received after February 15, 2012 will be processed at the conference hotel.

Seating for the Saturday evening banquet can be made in advance. If you register on line, you will also be able to make your table reservations.

1. The registration page will include the table arrangement for the banquet and will show which seats are available.
2. You can move the cursor over each table to see which guests have seats reserved.
3. You will select desired seats for yourself and each guest.
4. You will receive an email confirmation once your registration is submitted and seats are reserved.
5. Once submitted, any changes to your registration or seating must be made by contacting this office.

For those of you who do not reserve your seating online, you can reserve your seat(s) when you pick up your packet.

The Agenda and the Conference Committee listing will be posted December 15, 2011 at [www.ngatn.org](http://www.ngatn.org). Each committee member will be mailed a separate notification.

Hotel reservations at the Embassy Suites Murfreesboro Hotel and Conference Center must be confirmed by February 9, 2012 in order for you to take advantage of the special group rate. All hotel accommodations require a \$118.00 room deposit, which is fully refundable if cancellation is received 24 hours prior to your arrival date. To reserve your room, call 1-615-890-4464 and ask for reservations. Be sure and tell them that you are attending the NGATN Conference in order to get the reduced rate. A room reservation includes a complimentary, cooked-to-order breakfast. There are 280 rooms reserved at the Embassy Suites. In the event that more rooms are needed, **enclosure #2** lists hotels within a five mile radius of the Embassy Suites.

Embassy Suites has agreed again this year for the hospitality rooms to be located in the conference area. As a reminder, all hospitality rooms will **remain closed** during the **business session** on Saturday morning.

The 16th Annual NGATN Golf Scramble will be held on Thursday, March 1, 2012 at the Old Fort Golf Club in Murfreesboro, TN. Lieutenant Nash LeGrand is the point of contact and the registration form is enclosed as **enclosure #3**.

The President's & TAG's Reception on Friday Evening will be held in the **Mirabella Grand Ballroom E & F**, 6 PM – 12 midnight. The Skyline Drive Band will provide the entertainment from 8 PM – 12 midnight. Arm Bands will be provided for this event.

This will be an election year for EANGTN. The President and Treasurer offices are up for consideration. Please check **enclosure #4** for Nomination and Election Application.

EANGTN anticipates holding a Bowling Tournament on Friday, March 2, 2012. The details have yet to be worked out so be sure and check our website, [www.eangtn.org](http://www.eangtn.org), after January 10, 2012, for registration.
